



WETT UP & AQUAPRO WETTING AGENTS

Easy to use wetting agent designed to assist with water penetration and retention where soils are dry and hard to wet. Improves general soil moisture efficiency in all turf situations including lawns, gardens and sports fields.



An all purpose wetting agent designed to improve water penetration and moisture retention in lawns, gardens and sports turf. Its advanced formula helps water move quickly into dry or compacted soils, ensuring moisture reaches the root zone where plants need it most. It keeps moisture in the soil longer, reducing water waste and promoting healthier, more resilient turf all year round.

How to apply a granular wetting agent:

ESTIMATE THE AREA

Work out the area of your lawn (length x width).

Low Rate: 2kg / 100m²

High Rate: 3.5kg / 100m²

GRANULAR APPLICATION

Apply to a dry lawn evenly. Using an Earthway spreader is recommended.

For very dry situations follow up with regular applications. Use every 2-4 weeks throughout warmer months.

WATER

Irrigate immediately after application with around 4mm of water.

The more you can soak the wetting agent into the soil the better it will perform and stay hydrated.

How to apply a liquid wetting agent:

ESTIMATE THE AREA

Work out the area of your lawn (length x width). For 100sqm Lawns use 200ml in at least 4 Litres of water. For 100sqm gardens use 300ml in at least 6 Litres of water.

LIQUID APPLICATION

Use a good quality sprayer for application. A 5-10 litre sprayer is ideal look for one with a wand or fan nozzle and quality fittings.

WATER

Irrigate immediately after application with around 4-6mm of water.

Use every 2-4 weeks throughout the warmer months

Lawn Maintenance Guide:



Fertilise twice in Autumn and twice in Spring



Mow regularly and avoid removing more than one third of the leaf at a time.



Avoid mowing during the heat of the day in summer to prevent stressing your lawn.

Recommended to use on all lawn seed varieties including Ryegrass, Fescue, Bluegrass, Bentgrass, Kikuyu, Couch, Buffalo and Zoysia.
